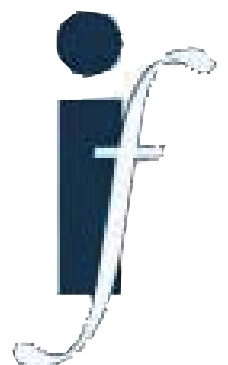


Impact Factory, more than just training: a company with a difference.

Our Ethos

The training you get from Impact Factory you won't get anywhere else and fundamental to our ethos is the need to offer people choices in the way they communicate and react to situations that arise at work and in life in general.

Impact Factory has been in operation since 1991, providing tailored Professional Personal Development programmes for the private and public sectors as well as a comprehensive series of Public courses and coaching for individuals. In that time we have run training programmes for well over 100,000 delegates, and in turn have impacted on two million people with the strength of our work.

Founding partners, psychotherapist Jo Ellen Grzyb and actor Robin Chandler, have created a body of work, along with their whole team, based on the guiding principles of their two professions:

- ◆ understanding that feelings can both help and hinder people's ability to manage their everyday communication issues including how effective, enthusiastic and motivated they are
- ◆ the easily doable behaviour change necessary to take on board new skills, build confidence and develop the self



If we could dispense with the word 'training' we would since our work is indeed, more than just training. We call what we do Professional Personal Development since we believe that if you can't use our work in the whole of your life (as opposed to only in the workplace), we haven't done our job.

Our view is that it is the whole person who comes into a training room, not just the work person, and the more we can relate our work to the whole person, the more effective and long-lasting it will be.



Here are a few more of our core beliefs that underpin all the work we do:

The smallest change for the biggest impact

Small doable tools and techniques are far more effective than going for wholesale change that won't last and is hard work. Simple changes can have a huge effect and people are more willing to try something that doesn't feel like climbing Mt Everest without a Sherpa.

There is no right way: one size doesn't fit all

How can there be since everyone is different. So no sheep dip training at Impact Factory. Our work is tailored to the people in the room, not adherence to a written programme.

Build and develop strengths

Being told what your weaknesses are or what you need to 'fix' can be completely demotivating and demoralising. Working with what already works is confidence-boosting, easier and gets immediate results.

Change yourself to change others

It's really really hard to change other people, much as we all would like to, so we concentrate on what each individual can do to change their situation. It's also very empowering.

Miscommunication is the norm

As clear as we think we are, someone out there is going to misunderstand what we're trying to say or do. Knowing this and having some quick-fire tools up your sleeve to 'rescue' these situations could save your 'communication bacon'.

Move it forward

It's easy sometimes to get stuck in the status quo, but it's so much better to have tools, techniques and confidence to move situations forward, and unstuck the stuck bits.

Secondly, they have to have high professional standards in everything they do with us; our aim is always to do the 'above and beyond' rather than the 'good enough'. All trainers undergo an intensive and on-going internal training programme at Impact Factory and are supervised by our Founding Directors Robin and Jo Ellen.

Our work is ‘experiential’, so people are on their feet doing

Impact Factory’s approach is an holistic one. We do not work in a linear fashion because we know that people don’t develop soft skills in a linear fashion.

We only ever focus on what already works about each person and use those strengths to help delegates feel more skilled, to teach new techniques and to give them additional understanding and insight into how things work between people.

Our work is completely bespoke, including our Open courses. Because no two people are the same, no two programmes should ever be identical: we are able to adapt each and every course to the specific needs of the people in it.

At the beginning of each course we gather input from the delegates on what they would personally like from the programme. From that input we make minor adjustments to the day’s work to address those needs.

The objectives always stay the same, and the core material remains the same. How those objectives are achieved may be slightly different. This means that everyone participating in our programmes has a direct input into the work, which ensures a far greater ‘ownership’ of the material than if it was imposed on them.

Anything to do with interpersonal skills, we can deliver.



Formats and Extras

Our formats are adaptable to fit what you need

Small group work is great when you need an intensive, in-depth exploration of a particular topic. Our preferred number in a small group is five or six for Presentation and eight to ten for other soft skills programmes. In this format people are immersed in the work with a lot of side coaching and individual, hands-on support.



Larger groups are great for putting lots of people through a 'shared experience' and these programmes can range anywhere from fifteen people to fifteen hundred, or even more.

Within this format we are dynamic, incredibly entertaining and we keep people hugely energised and engaged. Even in a large group we can build in a team development element if needed.

Public Courses

Impact Factory offer a huge variety of Open Courses covering all our core training issues ranging from Assertiveness to Writing Winner Tenders. These courses have a maximum of five to eight delegates and offer participants the best of Impact Factory's expertise.
